 - If certain questions do not apply, or you do not know the answer, mark with "N/A."
 - This form is for money seized in connection with drugs or gambling only, for all other seizures, follow the procedures at www.baltimorepolice.org/claim-property
- 2. Collect Supporting Documents:
 - Statement of charges
 - Defendant trial summary
 - Any other document supporting your claim
- 3. Submit Completed Form and Documents.

What's Next?

In approximately 10-12 weeks a BPD attorney will review your form, documentation and the police reports. If the reviewing attorney believes the funds are forfeitable under the Maryland Code, BPD may file a complaint for forfeiture in District Court. If that happens, the District Court will send you a "notice of intent to defend" with a court date. If the reviewing attorney does not seek forfeiture, the paper work will be forwarded to request the issuance of a refund check.
